Sending this email on behalf of both myself and my spouse Nathan Bylok. We are local residents in Mississauga [REDACTED] and we highly oppose Highway 413.

The 413 feels very unnecessary with the change in daily life the pandemic has brought on and will bring further. With commutes cut down due to work from home lifestyles there is no need to construct a new highway which would cause detrimental effects on the environment. It will cross rivers and water courses 85 times, it will destroy 400 acres of the Greenbelt, lead to more urban sprawl, increase greenhouse gas emissions when Peel Region has declared a Climate Emergency, harm our health with more air pollution, and cost provincial taxpayers \$6 billion.
