Dear Council,

I am a long time resident of Caledon, the land of rolling hills, greenscape and countryside. I am writing to urge you to oppose the construction of the proposed Hwy 413, because the definition of countryside is NOT land with no buildings and waiting to be developed, it is a landform that provides sustainable ecosystem services.
