Emerald Update

Unit 6 Approval

- Received approval to install a 6th EFW in March 2021.
- ► An additional 30,000 t of annual processing capacity.
- Approval will align installed capacity with approved capacity.

New Steam Turbine

- Installing new steam turbine operational in July.
- More efficient at producing steam for Cascades.
- ▶ Will reduce natural gas consumption and carbon emissions (12,000 t/yr).



Peel Volumes at Emerald

- ► Requesting Peel to divert up to 30,000 t of waste annually from landfill.
- ► Emerald has received Peel volumes since 2017.
- Good relationship Emerald has proven to be a convenient, reliable outlet.
- ► Emerald can re-allocate volumes to accommodate additional Peel volumes immediately.
- Prefer regular commitment to facilitate operations planning.
