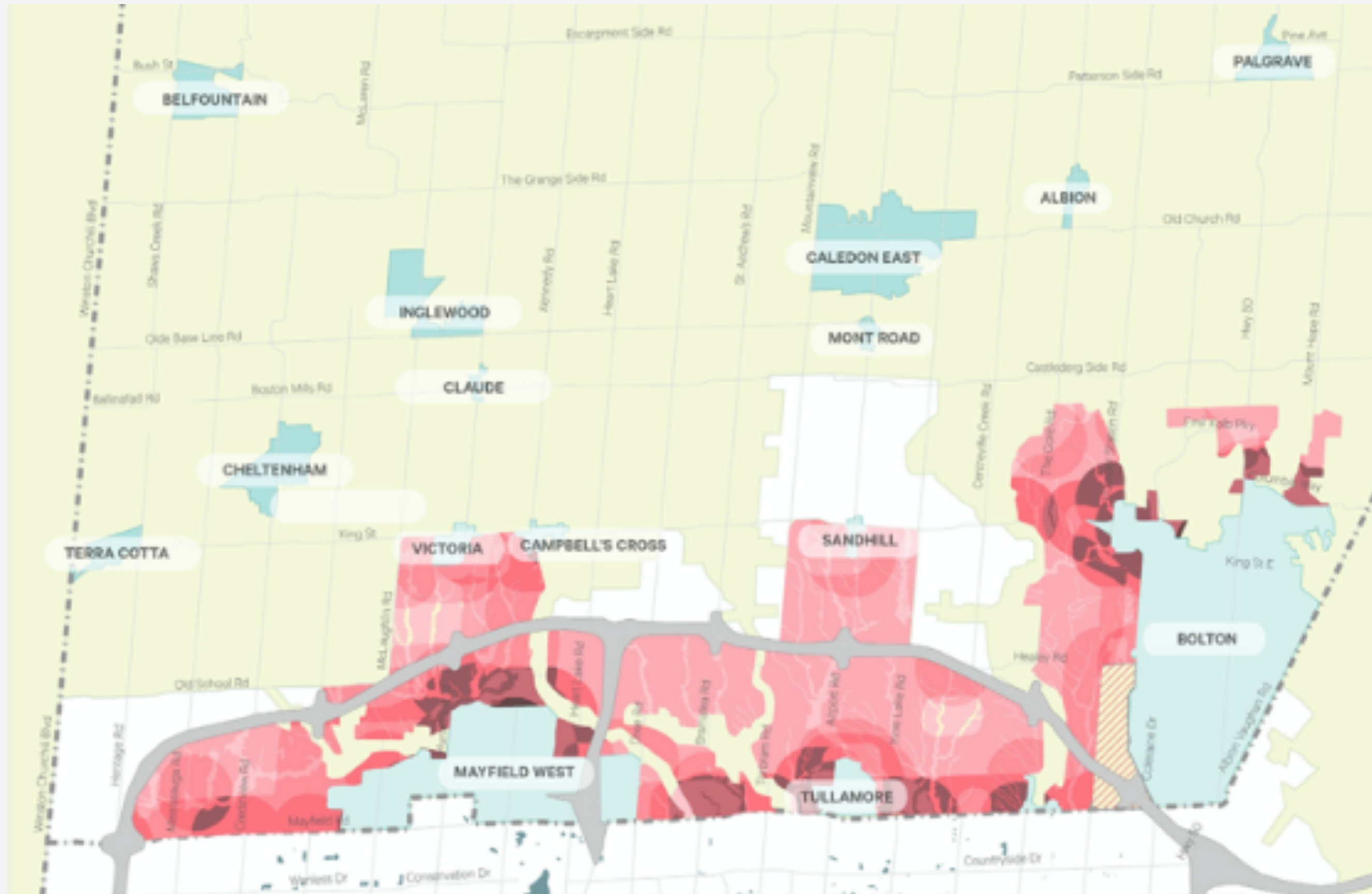

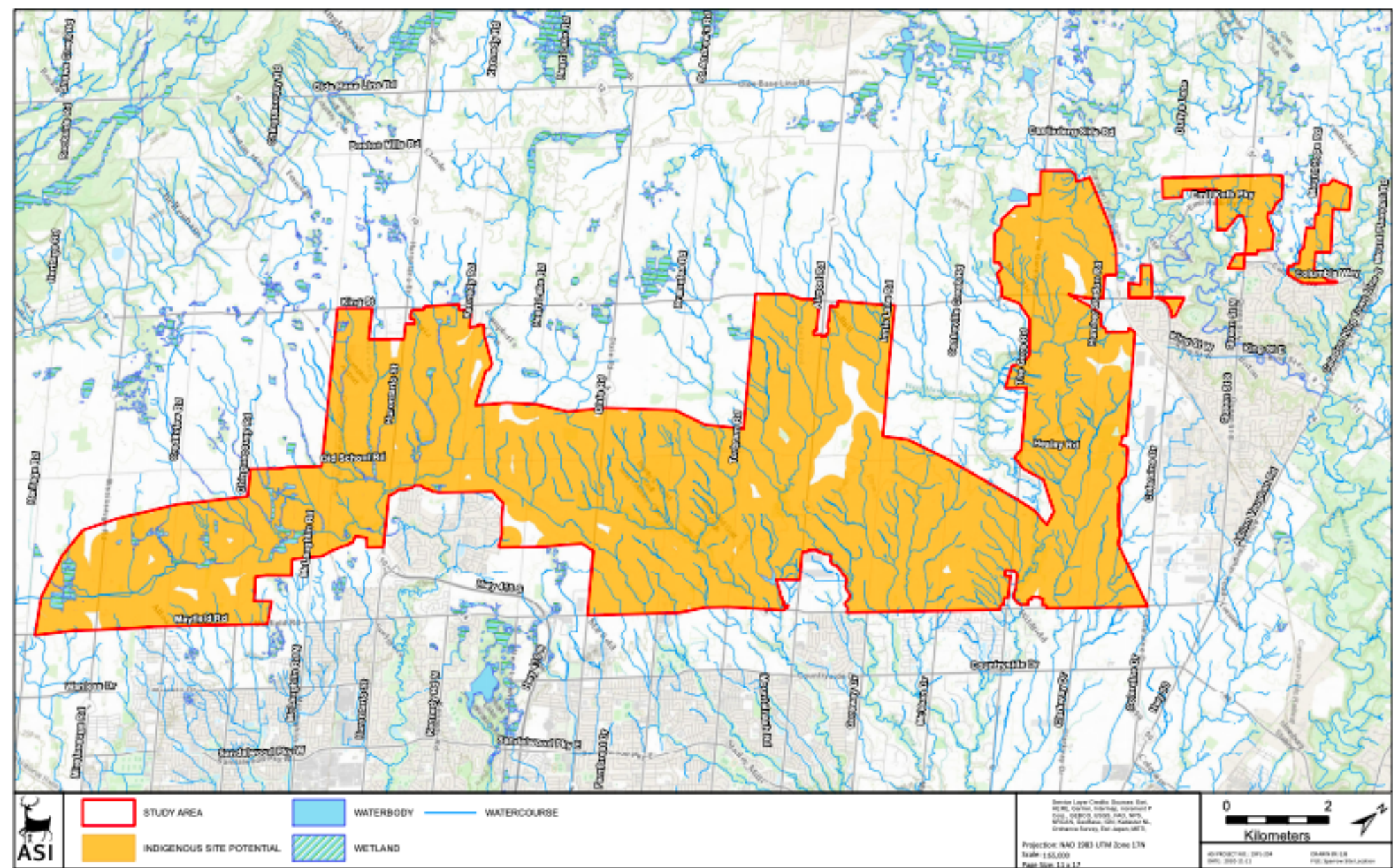
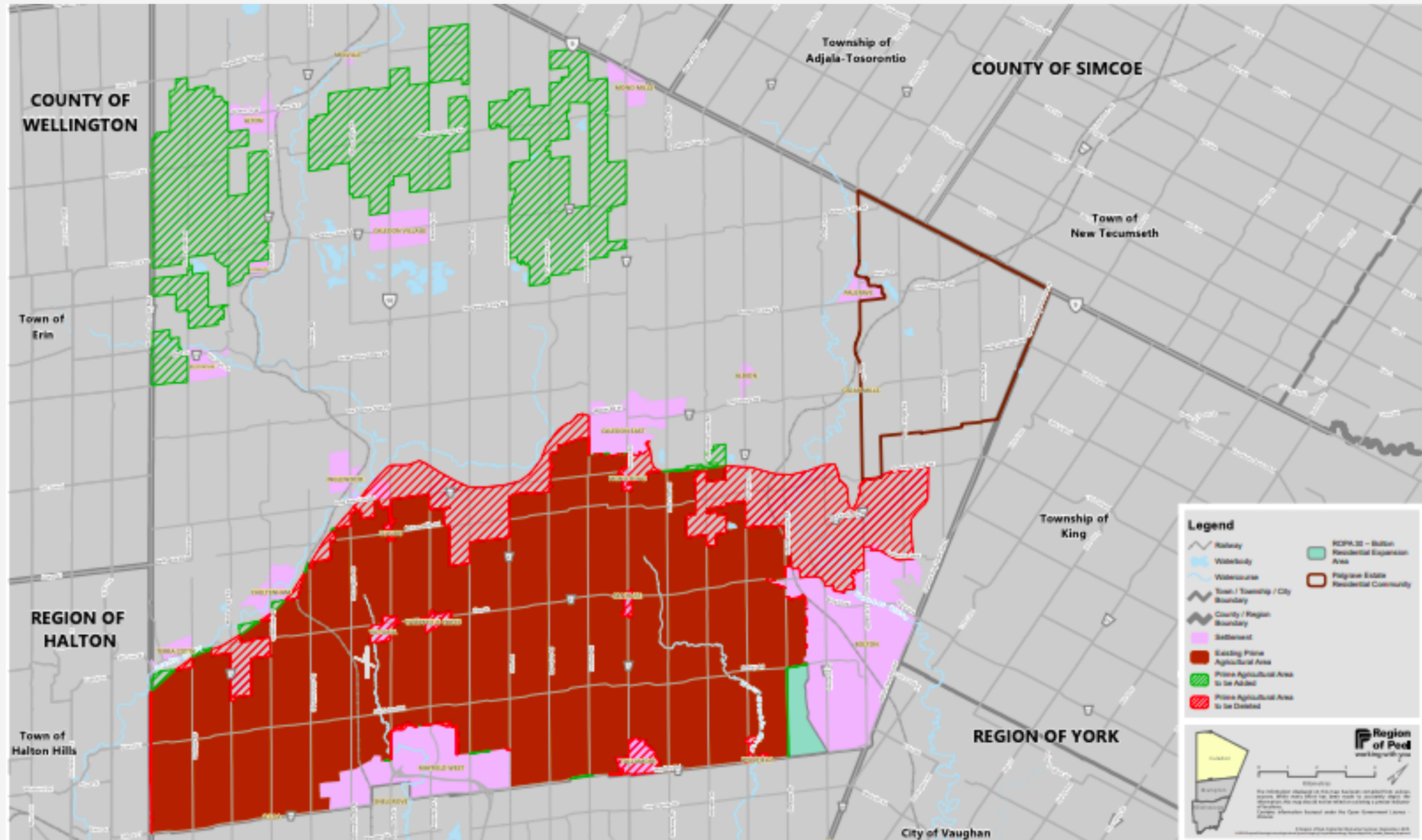


Figure 10: Region of Peel Settlement Area Boundary Expansion Study Indigenous Site Archaeological Potential
