Asking the Province to Reconsider is not Necessary

June 10th Resolution Number 2021-613

"...Therefore, be it resolved, that members of Peel Regional Council request that the Government of Ontario reconsider its position on an expansion of COVID-19 vaccine eligibility to children as young as twelve (12) years of age; and further, that the provincial government be requested to require that parental / legal guardian consent be required prior to vaccination of all children up to the age of sixteen (16) years of age within the Province of Ontario."

Thank you for your interest in submitting petitions to Peel Regional Council.

Please note that the actions requested in your three petitions are not primarily within the powers of local public health (Peel Public Health) /regional government (Region of Peel). For example, we do not have authority in regards to the public meetings held by a school board in Peel. Further, the validity of consent to treatment by a minor and the matter of exemptions from mandatory immunizations are governed by Provincial legislation (the Health Care Consent Act, 1996 and the Immunization of School Pupils Act respectively).

Regarding consent for ages 12 to 17, the Region of Peel has decided to rely upon the Provincial legislation (i.e. the *Health Care Consent Act, 1996*). Please note that the decision to vaccinate remains voluntary. Your request for documents related to the Region's decision can be requested via a Freedom of Information request as legislated under the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of*

Privacy Act.

A lack of parental consent / coercion in Peel could lead to excess, unnecessary harm to our kids

Peel's Language is also Leaving the Door Open to Lower the Age of Consent for Vaccinations / Coercion

"There is no minimum legal age to consent to medical treatment in Ontario, and in the nature of medical practice, this is in respect of an individual's own body as opposed to some other activities that an individual may engage in."

 Lawrence Loh, May 27 speaking at the Peel Regional Council Meeting in Q&A with Councillor Karen Ras Pfizer plans to submit emergency-use authorization requests in September, with one covering children 2 to 5 years old and a second applying to ages 5 to 11.

Pfizer is conducting pediatric studies to determine the safety and benefits of administering its COVID-19 vaccine to children as young as 6 months.

The company plans to submit two new emergency use authorization requests in September, with one request covering children from 2 to 5 years old and a second applying to ages 5 to 11.

A separate batch of results and a possible request, for children who are from 6 months to 2 years old, are expected in November.

- The Regional Solicitor has refused to provide guidance

Our young kids are not old enough to consent to a COVID vaccine with no long-term testing!

Objective: Increase the Minimum Age for Consenting to a COVID-19 Vaccine to 14 years old at a minimum. Ideally, we would prefer the minimum age be raised to 18.

Questions for Councilors:

- 1. What was the risk/reward studies and decision-making process behind allowing a 12-year-old to consent to take a vaccine authorized via interim order with an estimated study completion date not expected until 2023?
- 2. If no risk/reward study was done, why decide to rely on a Health Care Consent Act, 1996 that was written at a time when there was no pandemic and no emergency approved vaccines? Most provinces used their discretion and have not left the door open to potentially have a toddler consent to taking a vaccine authorized via interim order.
- 3. Will Peel region ensure schools do not discriminate against children or coerce those whose families decide the reward of vaccines authorized via interim order are not worth the long-term risk? This includes understanding the mental health implications of mask discrimination and the coercion this will lead to, not having doctors blocked from providing mask exemptions and having consistent social distancing measures no matter a child's vaccination status.
