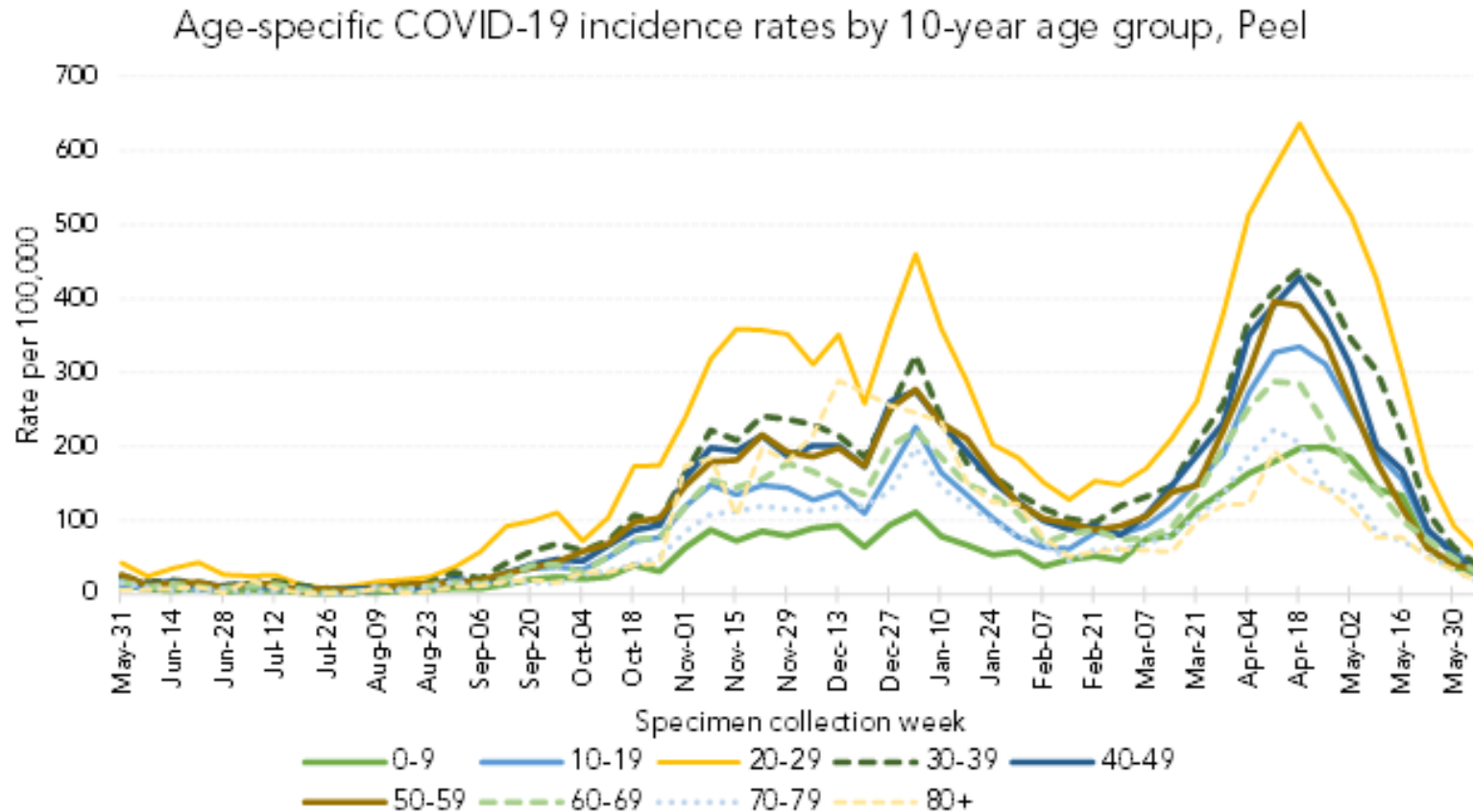

COVID-19 Situation Update

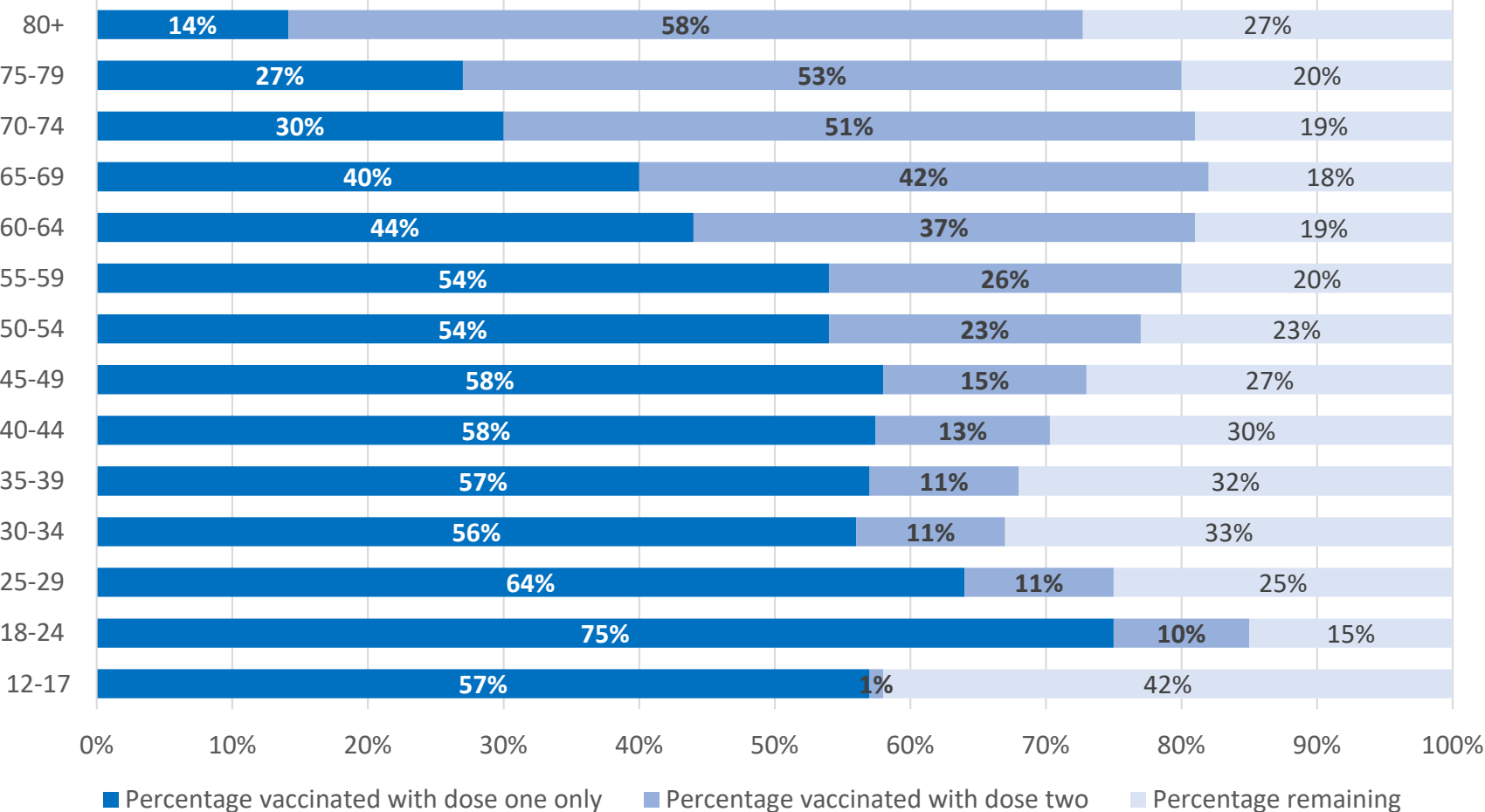


- Continued decline in incidence across all age groups and municipalities
- Approximately 50% of specimens are presumed Delta
- Slow, steady reopening to:
 - monitor the impact of reopening
 - increase our second dose coverage

Vaccination Update

Percent of Peel residents who have received dose one only and dose two of COVID-19 vaccine as of June 21, 2021 at 12pm



65% of total population
(**76%** of the 18+ population)
have received at least 1 dose
of vaccine

18% of total population
(23% of the 18+ population)
have received two doses of
vaccine

59% of the population 12-17
have received at least one
dose

Vaccination Update

- Getting second doses to Peel residents offers the best protection from COVID-19.
- Have available system capacity to deliver ~25,000 doses per day which is adjusted based on allocation.
 - Ensuring Pfizer is available for 12-17 age group.
- Continue to communicate safety and efficacy for vaccine interchangeability.
- Targeted outreach to promote vaccine confidence. E.g.,
 - High Priority Communities Strategy led by community agencies
 - Real Peel, Real Voices Campaign
