Concerns with the covid-19 situation

- No open discussion and debate on both sides of the issue

- Toronto Public Health admitted in 2020 that "individuals who have died WITH COVID-19, but not necessarily as a result of COVID-19, are all included in the case counts for COVID-19 deaths in Toronto."
- According to a recent study, the global survival rate for covid19 is 99.85% (average global infection fatality rate~0.15%) Source: Ioannidis JPA. - Vaccines still under trial. Long term side effects unknown. Multiple adverse events already reported.

- 80% of those who were severely ill had low vitamin D levels. Obesity increases the risk of mortality
