127 presentations and displays

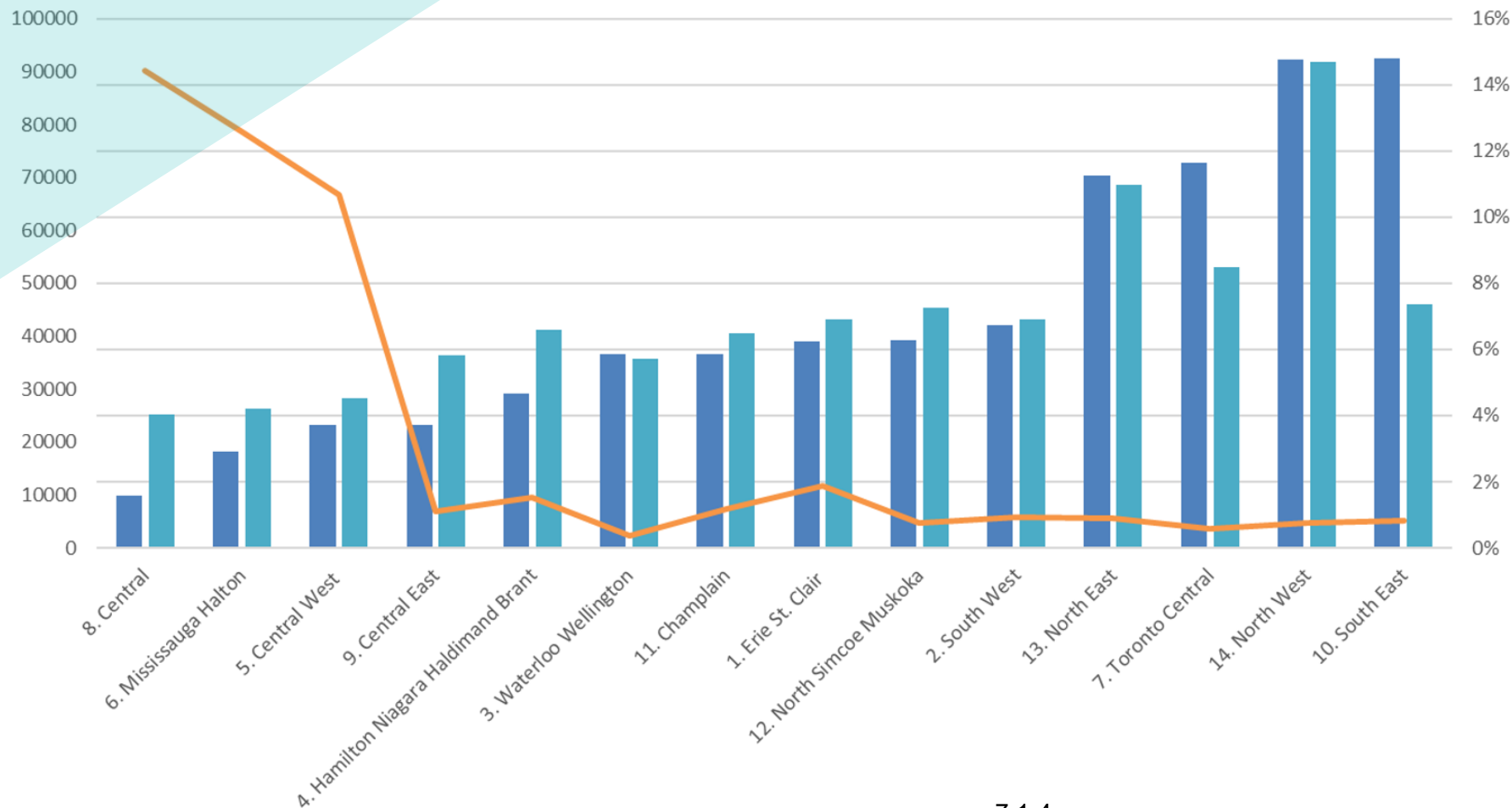

Setting the Context

Mental Health Services in Peel compared to Ontario

Comparison of Mental Health Resources and ED Visits across LHINs



Central West and Mississauga Halton have among the lowest per capita Community Mental Health funding and the highest number of residents per long term psychiatric beds.

The ratio of resident to psychiatric bed is:

MH – 1:78,649

CW – 1: 66,808

HNHB – 1:9,591

TC – 1:3,549

This is in stark comparison to comparison to Hamilton and Toronto:
