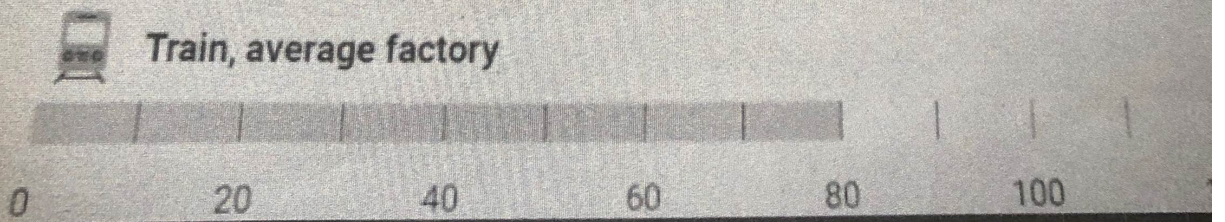

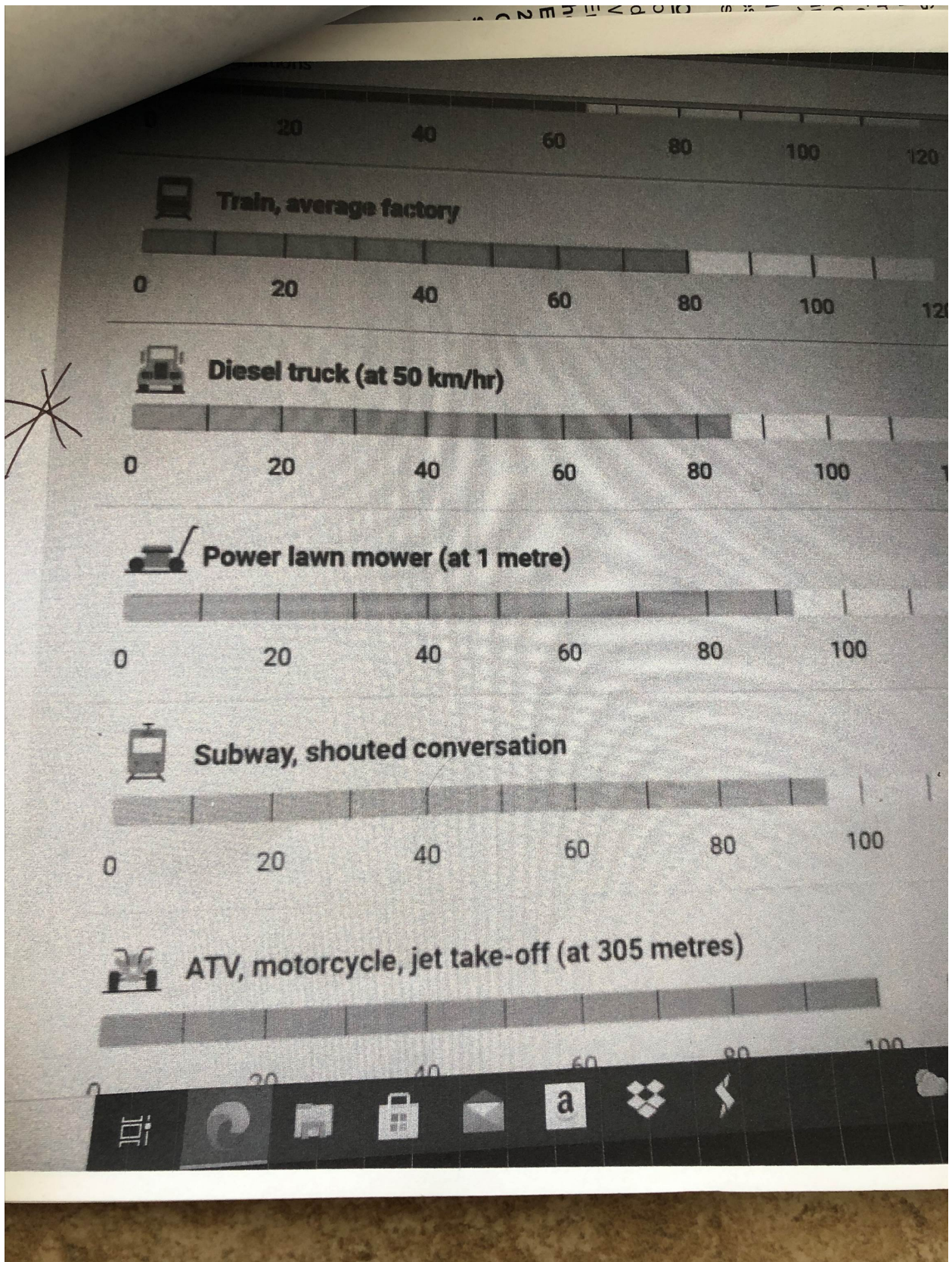

The intensity of sound is measured in decibels (dB).
To help visualize the wide range of sound, look at where
common neighbourhood noises land on the dB scale.

Animals


All animal barking,
calling, whining,
persistent noise

- Not permitted at any time


Construction

Sound from
construction
equipment

- Prohibited on Sundays and holidays
- Prohibited M-F from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Prohibited until 9 a.m. on Saturdays


Motor vehicles

Unnecessary motor
sound, horns, revving
engine, squealing tires

- Not permitted at any time



All types

- Can't exceed 92 dB while the engine is idle
