Subject: Request for meeting with council regarding long-term care

Mr. Iannicca,

On behalf of our organization, we are requesting to meet with council to discuss the lack of long-term care beds for Francophone seniors in Peel. On the advice of MPP Natalia Kusendova we would like to draw the Region's attention to this enduring situation.

There have been announcements for long-term care beds in Mississauga of late, however what is most disconcerting to us is that Francophone needs are not being taken into account by the Region when planning for its own facilities.

Retraite active de Peel is the only Francophone organization in Peel with a mandate to provide programs and activities to support healthy living for our seniors. We are totally 100% volunteer run and thinking to the future as seniors we are at a loss when it comes to long-term care.

We are part of an action group that focuses on four key areas: long-term care including palliative care, home care, primary care and mental health services. None of these are available in French although both Cities of Mississauga and Brampton – Regional Municipality of Peel are part of the designated areas under the French Language Services Act.

We look forward to providing you with more context and information when we meet with your council. MPP Kusendova hopes to be able to accompany us for this meeting.
