# Outcomes – March 2020 to April 2021

## Preliminary data shows that:

- An estimated 182 cases, 112 hospitalizations, 176 ICU admissions, and 31 deaths were **prevented** at the isolation site
- 58 clients received support for alcohol withdrawal
- 57 clients received support for opioid withdrawal
- 69 clients were transferred to hospital (across sites)
- 1854 PCR swabs for COVID-19 were performed
