Sustaining an Integrated Primary Care Model for the Homeless in Peel

A Response to the Region Of Peel Council Update

Thank You Region of Peel Thank you to the Region Of Peel and our community partners for your tireless support

Outcomes – March 2020 to April 2021

Preliminary data shows that:

- O An estimated 182 cases, 112 hospitalizations, 176 ICU admissions, and 31 deaths were **prevented** at the isolation site
- 58 clients received support for alcohol withdrawal
- 57 clients received support for opioid withdrawal
- O 69 clients were transferred to hospital (across sites)
- 1854 PCR swabs for COVID-19 were performed

Safe place to isolate and recover d/t effects of COVID-19

Renewed emphasis and advocacy for harm reduction and substance use services
