Hello,

I am submitting my statement in writing for yesterdays meeting that I couldn't attend as my time slot got pushed forward. Please see attached statement.

I believe it is possible to add a lot of new family homes to existing neighborhoods, rather than expand into our Greenbelt. I believe if we reduce demand for greenfield, proportionally, by getting rid of exclusionary zoning and adopting new rules designed to make adding more homes to existing lots in compact forms that we can also reduce the need to use our precious Greenbelt to build upon. Plan for smaller homes with less (or no) land wasted on on-lot parking and lesser side setbacks etc. Decrease the area of land required for industrial, warehouse, distribution centre developments by mandating land-efficient multi-storey typologies similar to what one sees in densely populated parts of Europe and Asia.
