Unprecedented affordability crisis



A minimum wage household needs **53 years** to save enough downpayment for an affordable mortgage.

An average income household needs **30 years** to save enough downpayment for an affordable mortgage.


Broadening advocacy



Need all of government approach

Policy levers and resources are **outside Regional jurisdiction**

Housing for homes



The share of **unoccupied** dwellings in Peel has nearly **tripled** since 2001.

By 2021, **1 in 4** homes sold in Ontario were purchased by **investors.**

About **3 in 4** purpose-built rental units in Peel are **40+** years old

Peel has **less social rental housing** than the OECD

More social supports to offset high housing costs



Average post-secondary **debt** for an undergraduate degree in Ontario was **\$30,000**

A living wage in Peel is \$4.80 more than Ontario's legislated minimum wage Peel Poverty Reduction Strategy

Meeting the scale of need for community housing



Estimated **70,000** low- and moderate-income households in core housing need in Peel
