Problem Statement



Water and wastewater revenue is variable based on consumption



Over 80% of annual utility operating budget are fixed costs



Increasing total cost of providing water and wastewater services



Lack of an integrated financial planning model



Cost to Serve Differences



Fixed Service Charge

Fixed Costs



>80%

of total annual costs

Fixed Service Charge

- Common industry practice
- Scaled to meter size
- Recovers 20% of revenue
 - ✓ Lowers volumetric rate
 - ✓ Smooths customer bills
- Ability to increase over time to align with industry range


Volumetric Rate

Single-Unit Residential: 2-tier rate

Multi-Unit Residential: 1 rate

ICI: 1 rate

ICI = Industrial, Commercial, Institutional



Bill Impacts

Customer Type	% of Customers	2021 Quarterly Bill	Quarterly Bill Change ²	
Single-Unit Residential	95%	\$165	\$7	4%
Multi-Unit Residential	1%	\$983	-\$42	-4%
Small Commercial	4%	\$294	\$16	6%
Medium Commercial ¹	<1%	\$7,542	-\$810	-11%
Large Industrial ¹	<1%	\$126,070	-\$16,823	-13%

¹Impacts for these customers are shown quarterly but are typically billed monthly.

Wastewater Rate Structure

Fixed Service Charge

Scaled to meter size



Volumetric Rate

Volumetric rate will be lower with fixed service charge

Residential: 85% of water consumption

ICI: 100% of water consumption

Water & Wastewater Rate Structure



Improves bill predictability and revenue stability



Aligns fixed costs with revenue recovery



Provides customer equity based on cost to serve

Next Steps

1. Complete financial planning model

Revenue required for infrastructure and state of good repair

2. Identify impact on rates

Combine recommended rate structure and financial planning model

3. Develop implementation and communications plan

- Potential phased-in rate implementation
- Implementation begins in 2024/2025
