
Background

- Construction projects are required to maintain service levels, but can also have short term negative impacts to the community (sound, dust, noise, traffic etc.)
- To mitigate these impacts, mapping technology was developed to make it easier and quicker for residents, businesses and Councillors to find information about current and future Regional construction projects.



Accessing the Construction in Peel Webpage





Searching CIP – Four Ways


#1 – by Address



<Enter> a street address in the format of {Street No} {Street Name} e.g. 300 City Centre and then <Select> the correct address from the returned list

Searching CIP – Four Ways


#2 – by Intersection



1 <Enter> a street intersection in the format of {Street Name1} & {Street Name2}
e.g. Queen&Dixie, and then <Select> the correct intersection from the returned list

Searching CIP – Four Ways

#3 – by Project Number


