Ministry of Health Agreement with The Regional Municipality of Peel effective the 31st day of January 2014 (the "Agreement")

I am pleased to advise that the Ministry of Health (ministry) will provide The Regional Municipality of Peel up to \$1,872,785 in additional base funding with respect to the 50/50 Land Ambulance Services Grant (LASG) for the 2022 calendar year.
