Ministry of Health Agreement with The Regional Municipality of Peel effective the 31st day of January 2014 (the "Agreement")

I am pleased to advise that the Ministry of Health (ministry) will provide The Regional Municipality of Peel up to \$1,872,785 in additional base funding with respect to the 50/50 Land Ambulance Services Grant (LASG) for the 2022 calendar year. This will bring the total maximum base funding available under the Agreement for the 2022 calendar year up to \$56,782,377.

I am, therefore, pleased to provide you with a new budget that, pursuant to section 4.2 of the Agreement, shall replace the budget in Schedule "B". All terms and conditions contained in the Agreement remain in full force and effect.

The Ministry will provide your organization with the funding noted in this letter subject to the Ministry receiving the necessary appropriation from the Ontario Legislature.

The Assistant Deputy Minister of Emergency Health Services will write to The Regional Municipality of Peel shortly concerning the terms and conditions governing the funding.

We continue to rely on your strong leadership in alignment with the plan to build a modern and sustainable public health care system and ensuring the on-going provision of front-line services that patients rely on every day.
