)	revising or updating the base map information in schedules and figures;
a)	altering punctuation or language for consistency;
b)	correcting clerical, grammatical, typographical or technical mapping errors;
c)	changing the style guide, format or font;
d)	adding explanatory or descriptive text, sidebars and images or graphics which are included for information purposes to assist users; and
e)	adjusting a <i>Major Transit Station Area</i> station or stop location, name, or code to reflect the actual built <i>infrastructure</i> or applicable information from technical studies.
