
- Applications launched April 2019
- First 24 OHTs approved Fall 2019
- Additional teams approved through 2020 and 2021

- April 2021
  - LHIN health system planning and funding functions transferred to OH
  - Home and Community Care Support Services

- November 2022
  - Common clinical pathways
  - New not for profit corporation created to manage and coordinate OHT activities
  - Standardized group membership
  - Identifying an Operational Support Provider (OSP)
  - Consistency in OHT-led public communications

- 54 OHTs across the province
- OHTs will cover 95% of Ontarians at maturity




