Our Team

Nurse Led Self-Governing Service with all staff, including leadership, being practicing nurses.

22 nurses – Registered Practical Nurses, Registered Nurses, Nurse Practitioners

Average Age - 38 with a number of second career nurses

Cultural Diverse – 83% BIPOC , 40% Black

Leadership – 83% BIPOC, 50% Black

Residency – 20 out of 24 staff live in the Region of Peel.

Accomplishments

From December 2020 to December 2022, over 4000 unique patients were served in the Region of Peel, across all programs. All individuals were homeless or precariously housed, many of which had contracted COVID.

Developed a partnership with TMU and McMaster University to train students.

June 1, 2023 marks the 1 year anniversary of the Dundas Medical Shelter. Results will be presented at the June Council Meeting.
