THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF PEEL

BY-LAW NUMBER 34-2023

A by-law to implement a revised Peel Emergency Plan and to repeal By-law 78-2015.

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter E.9 as amended, every municipality is required to formulate, and adopt by by-law, an emergency plan governing the provision of necessary services during an emergency and the procedures under and the manner in which employees of the municipality and other persons will respond to the emergency;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient to maintain a comprehensive Emergency Plan and Emergency Management Program for The Regional Municipality of Peel in order to ensure the provision and co-ordination of necessary services in the event of a major emergency or disaster;

AND WHEREAS, it may be necessary from time to time to update the annexes and appendices of the Peel Emergency Plan;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Regional Corporation has by resolution adopted on the 22nd of June 2023 authorized the enactment of a bylaw to repeal By-law 78-2015;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Regional Corporation enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law 78-2015 is hereby repealed;
- 2. That the Peel Emergency Plan and the Emergency Management Program provided for under the Peel Emergency Plan attached hereto as Schedule "A" to and forming part of this By-law, is hereby adopted;
- 3. That authority to update the annexes and appendices of the Peel Emergency Plan is hereby delegated to the emergency management program coordinator for The Regional Municipality of Peel designated pursuant to section 10 of Ontario Regulation 380/04 (Standards) of *Ontario's Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter E.9.
