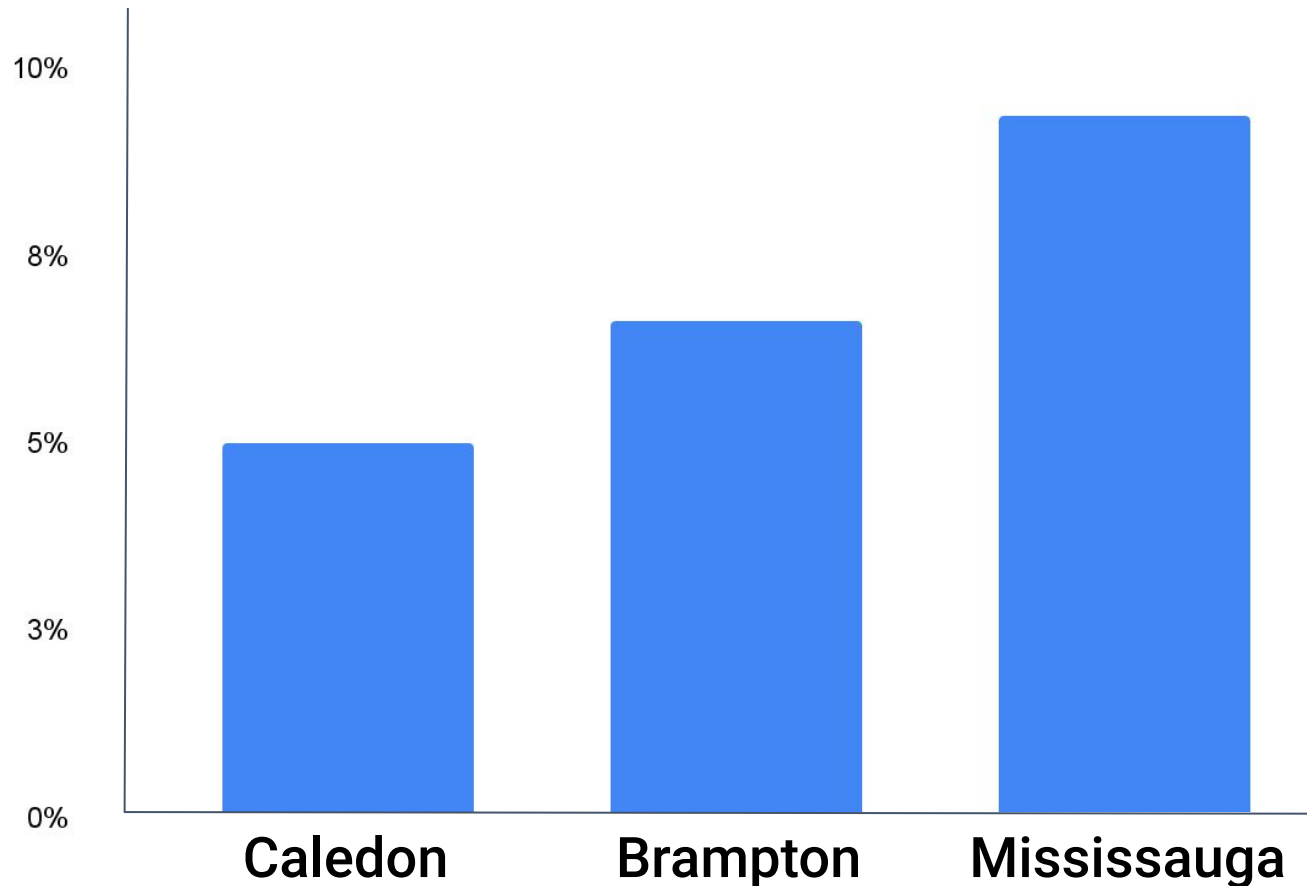

## Facilities

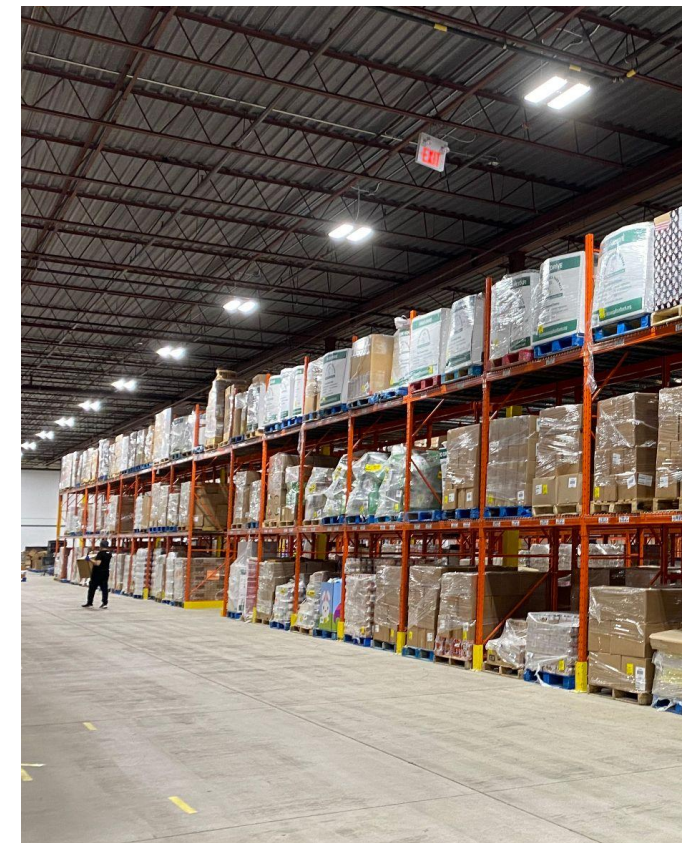
- Year 1: Offsite storage to allow for the input and output required to meet demand
