Whereas The Regional Municipality of Peel administers a Red Light Camera program to improve road safety and reduce collisions at signalized intersections across Peel Region;

And whereas, the Region of Peel's current agreements with the City of Toronto enabling Red Light Camera enforcement expire on December 31, 2026;

And whereas, maintaining continuity, reliability, and cost-effective processing of Red Light Camera offences is essential to the effective operation of the program;

And whereas, the City of Brampton operates an established and fully functional processing centre with demonstrated capacity, experience, and compliance with all applicable provincial requirements;

And whereas, a Peel Region-based processing centre will enhance service responsiveness, accountability, and provide local economic benefit, including the support of local employment;

Now therefore be it resolved:

1. That staff be directed to immediately initiate discussions and negotiate directly with the City of Brampton as the delivery option regarding the processing of Red Light Camera enforcement services utilizing the City of Brampton's processing centre beyond December 31, 2026; and
2. That staff be directed to execute an agreement comparable to the terms of the current agreement in a timeframe that ensures service continuity; and
3. That a copy of this resolution be circulated to the Councils of the Cities of Mississauga and Brampton, and the Town of Caledon.
